

Converting EPS Files for use in CM32, CM Studio or Fabric Toolbox

THIS CONVERSION PROCESS WILL ONLY WORK IF YOU HAVE PHOTOSHOP INSTALLED ON YOUR COMPUTER.

If files are saved on a CD or DVD, place CD or DVD into your Drive and wait for the Files Window to open and click "Open Files"

or

If you have the file already on your Hard Drive, go to it's location on your Hard Drive.

Right click on the file to be opened e.g. test.ai or test.eps
Go to "Open with" option and then allocate Adobe Photoshop

A Window will appear with "Rasterize Generic EPS Format"

1. Make sure the Resolution is 300
2. Make sure the Mode is RGB
3. Make sure Anti-Aliased in **NOT** checked
4. Click OK
5. Go to File then Save
6. Change the Format to a colour accurate format i.e. .tif, .bmp, .pcx **NOT** .jpg or .gif
7. Click "Save In" down-arrow to locate Folder you wish to save your image
8. Click "Save"
